

Things are rocketing forward with great excitement at SCS!



- We're in final countdown mode towards Expo-Night next Wednesday, January 29. Expo Night is our way of showcasing student progress in reading and writing with our acclaimed Step-Up Reading Program.
- During the year, each grade learns to apply their reading skills to specially designed Science and Social Studies units of study. Learning to read in all subject areas is what separates our *Program* from all others.

Our **Step-Up Reading Program** provides all of our students with specialized instruction during each Trimester:

• Trimester 1: Unit 1 - Literacy Labs

• Trimester 2: Unit 2 - Science -- Informational Research Lab -

Unit 3 - Social Studies -- Argumentative Research Lab

• Trimester 3: Unit 4 - Genre Studies Lab

The Science Research Labs during the 2nd Trimester provided teachers with the time and tools to explicitly help students develop research skills and strategies for reading informational text. Each student selected their own topic to investigate from their grade-level theme (see side chart).

Mid-Trimester Performance Reporting

Teachers are updating their Gradebooks in preparation for **mid-trimester Progress Reports**. Focus of the Mid-Trimester Reports is to identify struggling students and communicate academic intervention plans to parents.

Mid-Trimester Reporting also connects in a natural way to our school-wide

Student Growth Data Project where we used data from Trimester-1 to create
a composite performance score for each student in Reading, Writing, and Math.

Teachers also selected six students to profile and build strategies around in an effort to
improve performance. We will be using data from Trimester-2 to update the composite scores

for all students. **Our goal** is to move all students to the next rubric performance level.

Reporting Data Software Update -- Illuminate, the product we have been using for attendance and grade reporting, will no longer be an available product. SCS is looking at changing over to SchoolWise -- a product that has earned positive reviews from our Information Technology Specialist, Dee Khaleck, who has used SchoolWise for multiple years with the Roseland School District in Santa Rosa.

This Friday at 3 p.m., an SCS team will gather to learn more about how SchoolWise can enhance our ability to manage student data. *Our goal* is to select a product with a user-friendly interface for both staff and parents.
